Introduction

School Goal

Student achievement and engagement in writing will increase.

Outcome:

Teachers and students will utilize Self-Regulated Strategy Development (SRSD) for writing across the curriculum, to support idea development, planning, organization, and revision.

Outcome Measures

- SRSD teacher fidelity checks on instructional implementation
- Students' pre and post instruction writing samples in opinion and informative genres
- Leading indicators will be present in student data sets (e.g. report card data will show a decrease in indicators 1 and 2, and/or data will show an increase in indicator 4)
- Student survey data connected to writing, feedback, goal-setting and engagement

Data for Monitoring Progress

- PLC observations and analysis of student writing, tracking progress for genre elements
- Student feedback through engagement, self-assessment conversations, and checklists/rubrics/surveys
- Parent feedback through regular School Council meetings, Parent/Teacher Conference conversations, and genre surveys sent home with students' writing and rubric

Learning Excellence Actions

- School-wide implementation of SRSD for Writing for all K-5 students
- Grade team SRSD implementation schedule
- Regular opportunities for students to receive feedback, self-evaluate and set goals using teacher-created checklists and rubrics

Well-Being Actions

- Explicit and recursive learning of self-regulation and self-talk strategies focused on executive functioning
- Communication and connection between school and home to include families as partners in learning

- Regular opportunities for collaborative and individual writing
- Use of diverse and engaging texts to provide opportunities for students to feel connected and see their identities reflected in the texts

School Development Plan – Data Story

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2024-25 SDP GOAL ONE: Student achievement and engagement in writing will increase.

Outcome one: Teachers and Students will learn and implement an evidence-based writing instructional approach, Self-Regulated Strategy Development (SRSD) for Writing, to support idea development, planning, organization and revision.

Celebrations

- Most students demonstrated improved writing skills in their idea development, planning process, and organization using genre structures
- Most parents reported improvement in their child's attitude towards and skills in writing
- All teachers implemented Self-Regulated Strategy Development (SRSD) for Writing with fidelity, meaning students received excellent research-based writing instruction

Areas for Growth

- Continue to build student understanding and use of self-regulation strategies for writing
- Increase opportunities for students to receive feedback and apply the feedback in their editing and revision process
- Implement SRSD approach across three genres: opinion, information and narrative

Next Steps

- Continue implementation of SRSD approach, with enhanced emphasis on revision skills and opportunities for feedback
- Collect and analyze student quantitative student writing data: pre-and-post student writing samples and report card data
- Continue to teach and support self-regulation skills and strategies connected to writing
